| Art & Design (Fine Art)                    | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 6</b> at <b>GCSE Fine Art</b> or a <b>Distinction at BTEC Level 2 Art and Design</b> for entry onto this course  |
| Art & Design (Photography)                 | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 5</b> at <b>GCSE Photography</b> or <b>GCSE Art</b> for entry onto this course.  |
| Biology                                    | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 6</b> in combined science GCSE as well as a <b>Grade 6</b> in <b>Mathematics</b> for entry onto this course  |
| Business                                   | Students must have achieved 5 good grades including a minimum of Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics and English for entry onto this course  |
| Chemistry                                  | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 6</b> in combined science GCSE as well as a <b>Grade 6</b> in <b>Mathematics</b> for entry onto this course  |
| Computer Science                           | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 in GCSE mathematics</b> for entry onto this course   |
| Design & Technology (Product Design)       | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>GCSE Grade 6</b> in Design & Technology. Given the Maths content in the exam a <b>minimum of a Grade 5 in Maths</b> is also required   |
| Economics                                  | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>GCSE Grade 6 in mathematics</b> and also a <b>Grade 6 in English Language</b> for entry onto this course   |
| English Language and Literature            | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language and English Literature.</b>  |
| English Literature                         | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language and English Literature.</b>  |
| Geography                                  | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>GCSE Grade 6 in Geography</b> and also a <b>minimum of Grade 5 in Mathematics</b> for entry onto this course.  |
| History                                    | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 in GCSE History</b> for entry onto this course   |
| Maths                                      | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 7</b> in <b>GCSE Mathematics</b> for entry onto this course  |
| Further Maths                              | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 8</b> in <b>GCSE Mathematics</b> for entry onto this course  |
| Media                                      | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 for English Language or English Literature</b> for entry onto this course. A qualification in Media at GCSE is not required but an ability to use ICT is also desirable. |
| Music                                      | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 for GCSE Music or equivalent</b> for entry onto this course. A minimum standard of Grade 4 on their chosen instrument is desired.  |
| Physical Education                         | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 in GCSE Physical Education</b> as well as a <b>Grade 6 in GCSE Core Science and Additional Science</b> for entry onto this course.                                       |
| Physics                                    | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 6</b> in combined science GCSE as well as a <b>Grade 7</b> in <b>Mathematics</b> for entry onto this course  |
| Politics                                   | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 6 in either History or Geography</b> as well as a <b>Grade 6 in English</b> for entry onto this course.  |
| Psychology                                 | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 in both GCSE English, Maths and 6 in Science</b> for entry onto this course.   |
| Religious Studies                          | Students must have achieved a minimum of a <b>Grade 6 Philosophy and Ethics or Religious Studies</b> and <b>Grade 6 for English Language or English Literature</b> for entry onto this course.                                 |
| Sociology                                  | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 6 GCSE Sociology or similar subject</b> as well as in <b>English</b> for entry onto this course.   |
| Applied Psychology - BTEC                  | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 5</b> in combined science <b>GCSE</b> as well as a <b>grade 5 in Mathematics and English</b>   |
| Applied Science - BTEC                     | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 5</b> in combined science <b>GCSE</b> as well as a <b>grade 5 in Mathematics</b>   |
| Food Science and Nutrition - WJEC          | Students must have achieved a minimum of <b>Grade 5</b> in combined science <b>GCSE</b> as well as a <b>grade 5 in Mathematics and English</b>   |
| Health & Social Care – Cambridge Technical | Students must have achieved 5 good grades including a minimum of <b>Grade 5 in GCSE Sciences, Mathematics and English</b> for entry onto this course.  |
| IT - Cambridge Technical                   | Students must have achieved 5 good grades including a minimum of Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics and English for entry onto this course  |
