Culture update: Coundon Recognition

Recognition for positive engagement with the school was raised as positive feedback within our parental questionnaire and you will notice this term that students will be in receipt of an increased number of coins and badges on their class charts. Each week in this briefing we will be sharing which students have achieved badges following being issued coins by their teachers. Next week, we will also be activating the student class chart accounts so that students (when outside of school) can access this themselves.
